Cost varies according to what you can pay. Cost includes S/N, ear tip and rabies shot.

Costs: feral - \$25; pets - \$50 for male, \$70 for female

Payment by cash or check is due when cat is dropped off. They can also come to you and do the trapping for \$35.00 a cat.

All cats will receive rabies and FVRCP vaccines, revolution treatment for fleas, ear mites and worms, ear tipping for feral cats.

Intake 8:30-9:30 am morning of clinic (drop off the night before must be pre-arranged).

Appointments are required.

Must use participating vets - we like Dr. Maxian in Ringoes 788-7776. The rabies shots and any other shots needed will cost you extra. No cats/kittens under 5 months old.

If you have younger cats please contact Hunterdon Hills Animal Hospital (Rte 22 East in Whitehouse Station). They charge quite a bit more for shots (currently around \$44.00 each) than Dr. Maxian and may require you to get them.
